The foreign trade data reflects a clear image of the stages of economical growth in the State of Qatar, as it shows the commodities flow in the shape of national exports, re-exports, or imports from different countries of the world.

This bulletin contains detailed tables for visible imports and exports and re-exports by country of origin and country of destination.

The commodity tables are classified by divisions, sections and items of the Harmonized System (H.S.) issued by the United Nations, which was adapted according to local needs to meet the actual movement of foreign trade in the country, in addition to other statistical tables.

The custom entry issued by the General Authority of Customs and Ports is the main source of statistical information published in this bulletin according to the Special Trade System adopted by the State of Qatar.

This is the seventh bulletin issued by the Planning Council, hoping that we succeeded in preparing this bulletin to serve users of foreign trade data. We welcome any suggestions that contribute in improving this bulletin in the future.
